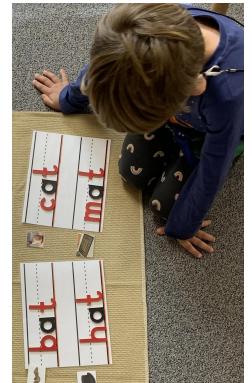


# Khalsa Montessori Teacher Education Program

## Open the door to worldwide job opportunities



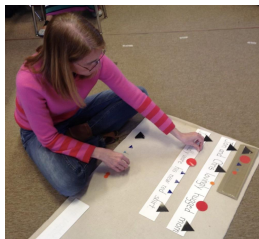
